## St. Lawrence Academy Sex Offender Policy

In Addition to the rules for registered sex offenders promulgated by St. Lawrence Orthodox Christian Church (SLOCC), and any rules and restrictions required by law enforcement agencies, sex offenders shall be subject to the following with respect to St. Lawrence Academy (SLA).

## A: For SLOCC Attendees

- 1. Sex offenders shall stay off all church property (including the office, bookstore, front patio, and north parking lot) during school days between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3:45 p.m.
- 2. Sex offenders shall not attend any school functions (including 8 a.m. weekday Divine Liturgies, Open House, assemblies, or fundraising events) unless specifically authorized by the principal.
- 3. The identities of sex offenders which have been disclosed to the SLOCC administration shall be disclosed to the school principal.

## B: For parents and guardians of SLA students

- 1. SLA strives to provide a safe and secure environment for all students. If any parent or household member of a prospective student is a registered sex offender, the offender must identify him/herself to the principal at the time of application.
- 2. SLA policy prohibits any parent or household member on the sex offender registry from volunteering at the school under any circumstances. Additionally, any person on the registry is not permitted to attend any school activities or functions (including 8 a.m. weekday Divine Liturgies, Open House, assemblies, or fundraising events) unless specifically authorized by the principal.
- 3. Sex offenders shall stay off all church property (including the office, bookstore, front patio, and north parking lot) during school days between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 3:45 p.m., unless inside a vehicle for the purpose of picking up or dropping off a student.
- 4. SLA may publicize or announce the persons listed on the registry to other Academy parents or the community as deemed appropriate. SLA parents, as well as applicants, may also request to view state sex offender registries in the school office at any time.

SLA teachers and staff will be apprised of the identities of sex offenders as outlined in A and B above and are tasked with the enforcement of Academy policy.
